## PROFESSIONAL COMPONENTS NEEDED

<b>Primary care projects</b>	Physicians, dentists, pharmacists, dermatologists, optometrists, ophthalmologists, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, nurses, first responders, dental hygienists, dental assistants, physical/occupational therapists, medical and dental students, servants (non-medical helpers), and a trip photographer/videographer on all of our general medicine and dentistry trips. Only minor surgery is appropriate.
<b>General Surgery projects</b>	General surgeons, Urologists, GYNs, Anesthesiologists, CRNAs or nurses, Scrub Techs and PAR nurses.
<b>Specialty Surgery projects (Plastics, ENT, Dermatology, Orthopedics, Urology, OB/GYN, Maxillofacial, Ophthalmology)</b>	Appropriate Surgeons, Anesthesiologists, CRNAs or Nurses, Scrub Techs, PAR Nurses and Residents - Unless proper facilities, support & local physicians are available--no high-risk surgery or procedures requiring extensive follow-up are performed.
<b>Prison projects</b>	These teams work in conjunction with Prison Fellowship ministering within prisons. Participants must be at least 18 years of age.
<b>Medical technologists</b>	Needed for projects where laboratory facilities are available.
<b>Psychiatrists, clinical psychologists, other mental health professionals</b>	<b>Please contact the CMDA Psych. Section for more information, <a href="mailto:psychsection@cnda.org">psychsection@cnda.org</a></b>
<b>Support staff</b>	Needed for duties ranging from sterilizing instruments to registering patients. Many spouses and teenagers find this a rewarding way to have a role in the professional ministry of their spouse or parent. Please note that minors (under 18) are not appropriate on prison ministry, human trafficking, or refugee projects.

Dates listed are U.S. departure and “return home” dates. Project Fee costs include meals, room and board, ground transportation, emergency medical insurance and other expenses. **Immunizations, passports/visas, and airline tickets are separate costs not included in the Project Fee.** A \$150 non-refundable application fee is required when applying. If the project is fully booked, or if an application is not approved, the application fee may be refunded or put on reserve for up to one year for another GHO trip. **Airline tickets are non-refundable once purchased. In the event of participant cancellation from a trip, or cancellation of a trip by GHO, participants will have airline credits to use in accordance with the applicable airline’s fare rules.**

Trip participants are expected to travel with the team and arrive together in-country. Note the airfare costs listed on ServiceReef are ESTIMATES and participants will be charged the actual cost of their ticket at the time of purchase.
