CMDA/GHO POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR VOLUNTEER SERVICE

- Project Fees, Registration Fee, Tax Receipts & Cancellations: The *project fee* is used to cover part of the GHO project operational expenses and cannot be prorated for partial participation. If the project is fully booked or if an application is not approved, the full amount of the *registration fee* will be refunded. Those who cancel after tickets are secured in their name are responsible for the cost of the ticket and will be sent their tickets to use or exchange at the discretion of the vendor. US IRS Tax-deductible receipts will be sent for all donations contributed for CMDA project expenses. Donation checks should be made out to CMDA/GHO with the participants name in the memo field. Cancellations MUST be submitted to GHO in writing.
- ◆ Incomplete Applications and Documentation: Incomplete applications, or those not accompanied by the necessary fees and/or supporting documents will not receive favorable consideration. A signed Travel permission form and waiver, with the registration fee must be submitted for EACH project. "Standing" applications are not legally binding and will not be kept on file.
- ◆ Expectations for Exemplary Conduct: In adapting to the contextual expectations of those we seek to serve, there are some practical restrictions we must all agree to follow for the duration of each project: No alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, or attending bars and discos. In addition to being circumspect in public, immoral private behavior is not condoned by CMDA. Only married, heterosexual couples may share a room when double accommodations are available. Unmarried couples should not leave the project area alone. Our actions and relationships should be modeled upon those of our Lord's life and ministry, which was above reproach. By going to serve and not be served (Mark 10:45), CMDA teams truly discover what Jesus meant when He said, "it is more blessed to give than to receive." (Acts 20:35)

All participants in CMDA short-term foreign mission projects are expected to adhere to these standards of conduct. Anyone who cannot accept these terms for the duration of the project should not apply. The Team Leader is obligated by CMDA policy to dismiss anyone who betrays the trust of the group by violating these standards, and his or her decision in the matter will be final.
